



Pilot Notes:

1. Prior Permission of 48 hours and coordinated arrival time is required for the efficient management of aircraft.
2. Acceptable VMC Minima: 8,000 metres visibility and cloud-base of 1,500 ft.
3. Inbound aircraft should contact “Galway Traffic” RTF at 10nm radius from the airfield.
4. Visual holding points are as follows with Minimum Holding Altitude of 1,000 ft:

NORTH: Claregalway Abbey (ruins) 053°20'49" N; 008°56'42" W : **260/080 right turn.**
From North Hold to EICM: Tk(M) 180°; Dist. 2.8 nm.

SOUTH: Water Tower near Oranmore 053°16'26" N; 008°54'16" W: **260/080 left turn.**
From South Hold to EICM: Tk(M) 322°; Dist. 2.1 nm.

5. EICM coordinates: 053°18'01" N; 008°56'30" W

6. EICM Runway:

RWY 08	TORA	TODA	LDA	Elevation

RWY 26	TORA	TODA	LDA	Elevation
	1289 m	1349 m	1212 m	81 ft

7. After landing, aircraft can exit the runway via either Taxiway A or Taxiway B as directed. Marshalls, wearing Orange Vests, will assist pilots to their parking spaces.

8. Pilots and their passengers are kindly requested to wear yellow high-vis vests on the ramp.
